Allan Hall Gwynne, 74, of Ocala, FL, passed away on May 15th, 2025 in his Ocala, FL home in Del Webb Stone Creek. Allan was born in Glasgow, Scotland to Joseph and Jessie Gwynne on April 9, 1951.
