Archie Melvin Fiessler, 87, born January 2, 1933 in Wayne, New Jersey to Rudolph Fiessler and Elizabeth Pyshe Fiessler, passed away December 29, 2020 in Alachua County, Gainesville, Florida. While Archie was born in New Jersey, he lived almost his entire life in the State of Florida. He served in the U.S. Army, and was stationed in Germany where he worked with the Army motor pool. Archie was a truck driver most of his life, completing both local and long distance assignments. He was an avid NASCAR fan, and worked as both mechanic and pit crew for many years on the local racing circuit. He was a devoted fan of #3. In his "retirement," Archie had his own landscaping and lawn care business. He continued to work in lawn care well into his 80's. Archie was an active member of Ascension Lutheran Church in Ocala, where he held the position of Head Usher. He was an active volunteer in visiting the church's homebound members, and in caring for the church property. Archie was preceded in death by his first wife Virginia Fiessler in 1993, and his second wife Joan Weygand Fiessler in 2012. Joan and Archie were married for 17 years. Archie is survived by his step-sons Rev. Peter Rustico (Barbara) and Jay Krosche (Lucie); grandchildren David, Timothy, Gregory, Amanda, Daniel, and Jamie; three great-granddaughters; his brother Fritz, and many nieces and nephews.
