Dr. Asim Kumar Dutt passed on to his eternal abode on Monday, June 26, 2017 at his home in Ocala, FL with his son by his side. He was born in Kanpur, India and received his medical degree from King George Medical College in Lucknow, India, where he met his late wife of 47 years. They migrated to the UK in 1960, and eventually to the US in 1974 to pursue their medical careers. He worked for the Veterans Administration in Little Rock, AR and eventually in Murfreesboro, TN where he was Chief of Medicine until he retired in Ocala, FL to be close to his family. He had a distinguished academic medical career marked by numerous publications in journals and textbooks in his specialty of Pulmonary Diseases. He was an avid fisherman, golfer and loved gardening and cooking. He adored his family and friends and above all, his faith. He was warm and loving, and touched numerous lives and was loved by all. He is survived by his brother, Ashok K. Dutt, his son, Anil, his 2 daughters, Ranjana and Tina, and their spouses, his 6 grandchildren, and his loving sister-in-laws, nieces and nephews.
