



## Barry Leskin

March 24, 1943 - May 20, 2020

Barry Leskin, beloved father to Matthew and beloved life partner to Ilene, passed on May 20th, 2020 peacefully in his sleep. Barry was born to Milton and Freida, his parents, on March 24th, 1943. He grew to manhood in Brooklyn, New York. Barry loved sports - both playing and watching. He was an avid golfer and loved the game. As a young man, Barry was a Brooklyn Dodger fan like most young men living in Brooklyn in the 1950's. When the Dodgers abandoned their fans and moved to Los Angeles, it left a hole in Barry's life that wasn't filled until the Mets started playing. Barry followed his father and most of his male relatives into construction and became a Sheet-metal Apprentice in 1960. He served a four-year apprenticeship and graduated to become a Journeyman Mechanic in 1964. That was also the year that Barry joined and served in the US Naval Reserves. He served from 1964 through 1967 when he received an Honorable Discharge due to injuries received while serving at Floyd Bennet Field in Brooklyn. Barry continued to work in construction for the rest of his working career. As a Sheet-metal Worker, he was a cutter, draftsman, foreman, and supervisor working both in the shop and in outside construction. He also owned and operated a sheet-metal business while living in Atlanta, Georgia. Barry relocated to Florida in 2010. He joined Rotary so that he could give back to the community and was a member of the Rotary Club of The Villages and The Rotary Club of The Villages-Evening. To his loved ones, relatives, friends, and those who knew him, Barry will be missed dearly.
