



Bozidar M Pancic

December 4, 1928 - May 4, 2020

Bozidar (Poncho) Pancic, passed away peacefully on May 4th 2020. He was 91 years old. He was born in Bela Palanka, a small rural town in Eastern Serbia in 1928. He enlisted as a Partisan to fight the Nazi's at 15 years old and served as a gunner in a fighter plane. He was shot down over enemy territory but managed to survive and return to his unit. He learned carpentry as a political prisoner after the war and migrated to Italy where he joined a production crew acting in Italian movies. He emigrated to America in 1961 where he established himself as a Master Carpenter and Cabinet Maker in Brooklyn NY. After the passing of his wife Helen in 2009, he moved to Ocala, Florida to be close to his daughter. Bozidar is survived by his sons Alexander and Miodrag, his daughter Marla, and 4 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren.
