Obituary of Carmen Rosario Carmen Rosario (Lowell) died of cervical cancer on Wednesday, April 27 in Gainesville, Florida. She was 52. Rosario was born May 6, 1958 in Arecibo, Puerto Rico. She came to the United States in 1963, at the age of five. She graduated from Port Chester High School in New York in 1976 and from Westchester Community College, also in New York, in 1979, and worked as a respiratory therapist for 30 years. She and her family moved from Port Chester, New York to Ocala, Florida in 2005. There, she was an active member of her church and of the church's Daughters of Bethany volunteer group. Rosario's daughter, Cristina Rosario, describes her mother by saying, "My mom took care of people. Anyone who crossed her path and was in need, she gave to them - gave her time, an ear to listen to, or a shoulder to cry on. She had compassion for every person she met. That was her greatest characteristic." Rosario's wake was held on Sunday, May 1 at Roberts Funeral Home in Ocala. The funeral Mass was held on May 2 at Blessed Trinity Catholic Church in Ocala, followed by a private burial. In addition to Cristina, a student at Northeastern University in Boston, Rosario is survived by her son, Robert Lowell, 19; parents Roberto and Julia Rosario; and sisters Alma Rosario and Julia Zapata.
