



Chandika "TEDDY" Persaud

June 21, 1941 - May 21, 2025

Chandika "Teddy" Persaud, 83, of Corentyne-Berbice, Guyana passed away on May 21st 2025 in Ocala, Florida.

Teddy was born in Fyrish, Berbice to his father, Moonilall (Mooni), and his mother Phunbrasso Moonilall (Bhan Didi) on June 21st 1941. He was the 3rd eldest of 10 children (6 brothers and 4 sisters). During his childhood and into adulthood he worked in a variety of agricultural roles (Combine, Tractor) in addition to being a land surveyor where he regularly went into the interior of the Amazon Rainforest.

Teddy married his wife Seitla Singh on January 19th 1964 and later moved to New York at age 28, where he raised 2 boys, Ramnarine "Romel" and Romeo. Moving from Queens, New York to Ocala, Florida in 1981, Teddy built a lifelong connection of friends and family alike bonding over things such as music, farming, horses where he always had a smile.

Teddy was preceded in death by his beloved wife Seitla. He is survived by his son Romeo and wife Nadira, as well as his son Romel and wife Sunita and their three children, his grandchildren, Narindra, Keshav and Priya. His later days were spent filled with joy from his friends turned family: Dave, Vijay and Anthony.

Funeral service will be held at Roberts Funeral Home located at 606 SW 2nd Ave, Ocala Florida 34471. The viewing will take place Friday, May 23rd 2025 from 6-9 PM ET and the funeral will take place Saturday, May 24th 2025 from 8-12 PM ET.
