Charles Allan Markland was born in Kingston, Jamaica to Henry and Rhoda Markland. He was educated at St. Francis School where he met his wife Clarice Loretta McCoy at St. Francis School and they married December 14, 1949. He worked as a Professional Cooper (maker of rum barrels) for Fred Meyers Cooperidge in Spanish town, Kingston where he later became the supervisor. Charles later migrated to England with his wife Clarice Markland and his three children. During his years in England, he worked in major British engineering company at "Guest, Keen and Nettlefolds". He was also a professional vocalist and professional cyclist. He then moved to America where he resided in New York and worked as an Engineering Supervisor at Rockefeller University Hospital then later moved to Ocala, Florida in 1977 where he worked in the Engineering Department at Munroe Regional Medical Center until he retired in May 1991. He was preceded in death by his son, Desmond Markland in 1993.
