Major Charles Alfred Trask was Promoted to Glory on December 31, 2021 from ICU at Advent Health Hospital in Ocala, Florida. He was born in Dunkirk, New York on August 27, 1946. Charles served in the United States Navy section of Intelligence. While in Vietnam during 1968, he was exposed to Agent Orange and battled prostate cancer and PTS for the last 24 years of his life. Following his military service, he joined the CIA traveling in Southeast Asia until he felt the call from God to serve in ministry of The Salvation Army, where he achieved rank of Major. Charles is survived by his wife of 45 years, Toni Trask; son, Charles Paul Trask; daughter-in-law, Edisa Torres and grandson, Eric Alberto Torres Trask.
