On the morning of December 22, 2022, Charlotte Ruth (Ropicky) Dantzman of Ocala, Florida, passed away at 86 years of age. Charlotte was born in Wyoming to John and Mary (Pizur) Ropicky on May 25, 1936. She spent most of her school days growing up in Cudahy, Wisconsin. After graduating high school she worked at Dutchland Dairy before being united in marriage to Thomas Gerald Dantzman on September 3, 1955.
