



## Dr. Christopher John Schmidt

Dr. Christopher John Schmidt, born on January 10, 1972, in Taunton, Massachusetts, passed away on April 29, 2026, in Ocala, leaving behind a life marked by devotion, accomplishment, and a deep appreciation for the people and interests that shaped him.

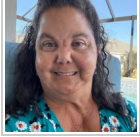
