Dennis Brenon, 72, of Ocala, Florida, passed away on April 8, 2022 with his wife and friends by his side. Dennis enjoyed his time working on the 25th and 30th Anniversary Woodstock Concerts. He also worked on motion pictures and television. Dennis loved running and ran over 20 Boston Marathons. His best time was 2h 42m. He served as team Captain of the UFD Boilermaker running team. Dennis was an avid rower, doing several regattas with his favorite being the World Indoor Rowing Competition in Boston.

While residing in Florida he was a member of the OTOW Theatre Group, where he worked as a stage hand as well as several acting parts. He was a member of the Ocala 200 Lions Club serving as a board member and a member of Meadowbrook Church in Ocala. He leaves behind an abundance of friends in Florida who were with him throughout his illness.
