Denver, 87 of Ocala, entered eternal care Wednesday, April 9, 2025, in his home with his wife. Denver was a devoted and loving husband to Maureen Pearson for 65 years.

Denver was born February 8, 1938 in McCurtain, Oklahoma to Charles and Ruby (Tucker) Pearson. Denver was a faithful follower of Christ, keeping his Bible near him daily. He was a member of the US Air Force for 20 years before retiring with honors, and then moved on to drive public transit buses in Broward County, Florida for 25 years.

When retiring from the Air Force, he and his family moved to Hollywood, FL to be closer to his wife's family. Later, when retiring from Broward County, he and his wife then moved to Ocala, FL, where they have resided since.

Denver was preceded in death by his older brothers, Charles Clemon Pearson, Jr., Clark Riley Pearson, and his eldest son, Dean Ray Pearson, who is survived by his wife Tammy Jo Pearson.
