Obituary of Dominic Marino
Dominic A. Marino "Dom" passed away on Tuesday, March 11, 2008 at his residence in Ocala, FL. Mr Marino was a native of Brooklyn, NY, He lived in New York and New Jersey until 1971 when he and Fran moved to the Summerfield/Ocala area where he lived until his death. While in New York, Dom founded and operated Matco Transportation in S. Kearny, NJ. He was also the founder of Hub City Terminals in Chicago, IL, which was built up to over thirty franchises throughout the U.S. and was eventually renamed the Hub Group. The Hub Group went public in the early 1990's and is still on the NASDAQ Stock Exchange. He was a pioneer in developing Railroad intermodal, formerly called trailer of flatcar service. After moving to Ocala, he was very active in Blessed Trinity Catholic Church. He was one of the founders of Trinity Catholic High School and the Marino Gymnasium at the high school is named after Dom and Fran. They also started the Marino family Scholarship fund at Blessed Trinity as well as the Marino Scholarship Foundation at Notre Dame Church in North Caldwell, NJ, Mr. Marino was greatly loved and will be missed by those who survive him, including his wife of 67 years Frances "Fran" Marino of Ocala, FL Son, Gary Marino (Joyce) of Wadmalaw Island SC, son James Marino (Brigitte) of Naples, FL daughter Fran Marino (Steve Farrell) of Ocala, FL grandchildren, Courtney Marino, Gary Marino, Jr. James Marino, Jr. and Sean Lea.
