Obituary of Donald Weber Don Weber passed away peacefully on April 14, 2009 after a brief struggle with cancer. Born on August 5, 1933, in Hutchinson, Kansas, he spent his childhood and early adult years in Wichita, KS before entering the US Air Force. While stationed in Georgia and Mississippi, he trained and became an instructor of jet fighter pilots, which instilled his love of flying. Following his service, he graduated from Wichita State University and made a career in geology and oil exploration in Oklahoma.
