Doug was born on February 6, 1943, and was raised in Windsor Locks, Connecticut.

Doug graduated from Windsor Locks High School and the Morse School of Business in

Hartford, Connecticut. As a teenager, he was an accomplished horseman, swimmer,

and diver. Doug enlisted in the United States Air Force and served as a communications

specialist in Spain.

Following his military service, Doug began working for the McDonald's Corporation. He worked his way up the corporate ladder from Assistant Store Manager to Director of Operations for the Boston Region. In this capacity, he oversaw more than 500 McDonald's restaurants in New England.

In 1985, Doug retired from corporate life and, as an independent owner operator, bought his first restaurant in Old Town, Maine. Doug's wife, Linda, eventually became a licensed owner operator in her own right. Together they grew their franchise to a total of seven restaurants throughout Maine. As a team, they received numerous business achievement awards. Doug was a member of both the Regional and National Operator Advisory Boards and a recipient of the Margaret Chase Smith Quality Award presented by Governor Angus King. Doug also established a golf tournament for children with cancer and was recognized by Children's Hospital of Boston for achieving the largest single year increase in contributions.

Throughout his life, Doug was an avid Corvette enthusiast and golfer. He was an active member of the Penobscot Valley Country Club and the Cape Neddick Country Club.

Doug truly enjoyed giving golfing advice to his friends, even when they really didn't want it. His good-natured presence and involvement will be greatly missed.
