Obituary of Dwight Carey Captain Dwight M. Carey passed away on Sunday, May 25, 2008 at Munroe Regional Medica Center in Ocala, Florida. He was a native of Harrod, OH, where he graduated high school. He then attended Adrian College, Mr. Carey was a US Army Air Corps veteran of WWII. After serving in the Air Corps, he became a captain for the Ohio State Highway Patrol, where he retired in 1973. From there, he held several positions, including Assistant warden for the Arizona State Prison in Florence, AZ, pinal Country AZ Sheriff's office Special Deputy Sheriff, and Clinton County Special Deputy in Wilmington, OH. He was the superintendent for the Sugar Grove Cemetery in Wilmington, Dwight was commissioned as a Kentucky Colonel in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and as an Honorary citizen of the State of Texas. He was a member of the American Legion, VFW, Ohio Highway Patrol Retirees Assoc., and the Ohio Troopers Coalition.
