



Edgar Augustus Clarke

September 21, 1928 - October 4, 2022

Edgar Augustus Clarke was born on September 21, 1928, in Chapleton, Clarendon, Jamaica to Adelaide Bryan and Cecil Clarke. He was the second of three siblings, brothers Herbert Cameron (deceased) and Joseph Clarke (deceased). His mother died when he was just 14 years old. After the passing of his mother, he moved to May Pen, Clarendon where he eventually met and marry Estelda who became his wife of 61 years.

He migrated to England in 1961 where he spent 17 years before relocating to the US and settling in Patterson, New Jersey. He later found residence in Lauderdale Lakes, Florida, and finally Ocala, Florida. During his life span, he worked at Sevens Estates, Clarendon, Jamaica, Ford Motor Company in England, and New Jersey at Daughter of Miriam Nursing Home for sixteen 1/2 years before finally retiring. During his retirement years, he remained active traveling with his wife and visiting churches, family, and friends until his declining health. For years he was a faithful and active member of the Patterson Church of God in New Jersey, serving as a Deacon, and at the time of his passing, he was a member of the World Outreach Evangelistic Ministry, in Ocala. He was one of its founding members, and over the years served in various capacities, as the first president of the Men's group, as a Deacon, and as a choir member. Edgar Augustus Clarke departed this life peacefully at home on Tuesday, October 4, 2022.

He leaves behind his loving and caring wife Estelda Clarke, nieces, nephews, God's children, and a host of relatives and friends. He was a wonderful,

loving, kind, and faithful husband, and his memory will live on forever among those whose lives he has touched. May His Soul Rest in Eternal Peace!
