Obituary of Edith Prignoli Edie Evangelista Prignoli, 91, of Ocala, passed away at Marion County Hospice on April 16, 2013. Born in Cranston, Rhode Island on June 16, 1921, she is survived by her siblings Michael Evangelista of Coventry, RI, Anna Mottram of Seal Beach, CA, Polly Martone of Burlington, MA and Victoria Parente of West Warwick, RI as well as numerous nephews and nieces, including her godson, Andrew Sorbo of Berlin, CT. She was preceded in death by her husband of 40 years, John Prignoli in 1984: sisters Esther Sorbo Margerison, Millie Chew and Mary Castigliero and parents, Francesco and Palma (DiLibero) Evangelista. Upon her retirement from General Electric, she and John moved to Ocala in 1973 and lived at Spanish Oaks since 1979. While John was alive, he served as a strong advocate for the Disabled American Veterans with Edie's active support. Although she had a hard life, Edie always maintained an optimistic attitude, a friendly personality and a ready smile which earned her many dear friends.
