Obituary of Edmund Janiak Edmund A. Janiak, 95, of Ocala passed away September 25, 2015. Born in Detroit, MI he came to this area 54 years ago from Gainesville, GA. Mr. Janiak was a US Marine Corps Veteran of WWII (5th Marine Division and was in the first wave of Marines to hit the beach in the invasion of Iwo Jima) and a US Air Force Veteran of the Korean War. He was also a retired business owner and music teacher and a member of Blessed Trinity Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, Sacred Heart Council #8012, Polish American Social Club and loved gardening and music. He was preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy "Dot", brothers, Walter and Barney Janiak and sisters, Regina Sikkenga and Angeline Borter. Mr. Janiak is survived by many nieces, nephews and by his very close and dear friend, Betty Bonnett. A Memorial Mass will be held at Blessed Trinity Catholic Church (5 SE 17th St., Ocala) on Tuesday, (Oct 27th) at 12:30PM. Mr. Janiak donated his body to medical research at the UF Medical School. He will be interred at a later date, with his dear wife, Dorothy at Florida National Cemetery, Bushnell, FL.
