Edmund Murdzek, 83, of Hudson, WI and Ocala, FL, passed away on August 4, 2025, in Ocala.

Known affectionately as “Mr. Ed” or “Grandpa Ed,” he was born in Green Bay, WI, on September 2, 1941. He attended school in Krakow, WI, and moved to Hudson in 1968, where he married Ellen, in 1969. They celebrated nearly 56 years of marriage together.

Ed spent over 30 years as a truck driver, later worked alongside his daughter and son-in-law at their HomeVestors business, and eventually retired as a Hudson school bus driver. In October 2024, he and Ellen relocated to Ocala, FL, to enjoy retirement.
