Obituary of Edward Bielling Mr. Edward R. Bielling, 84, passed away on April 27, 2008 after a lengthy illness. He was born Aug. 12, 1923 to John N. and Edith T. Bielling in Providence, FL, and raised in Lake Butler, FL. He was an Army Veteran of WWII, serving in a combat role in Italy.
