Obituary of Edward Keller Edward Charles Keller, 88, of Ocala, Florida, formerly of Lockport, New York, passed away at home under Hospice care on February 4, 2010. He was a retired steel worker who graduated in 1943 as a metallurgical engineer from the Missouri School of Mines and Metallurgy and later from Harvard Business School Advanced Management Program.
