Obituary of Edward Sreenan Born on August 20, 1921 in Janesville, Wisconsin, Edward Owen Sreenan was an accomplished individual whose life is best remembered as a bountiful one. "I had a lot of fun in my life," he would often say. His best piece of advice was to have fun and love God. This advice set the foundation in which Ed believed life was to be led: one must enjoy life, engage in the things that make one feel good, and don't be afraid of a little mischief. Above all, love God and believe in everything he has to give. In Ed's 92 years of life he experienced many things and accomplished even more. As a member of the U.S. Navy, Ed served in both World War II and The Korean War. His family thanks him for his participation in serving and protecting our country; he is a true American hero. Post-service, Edward dedicated much of his time to establishing life long memberships in particular organizations. He spent 54 years as a member of the Elks community of Rockford, Illinois, Lodge 64. Within this time frame, Edward ranked as a Past Exalted Ruler. He is also a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW), as well as an honorable Fourth Degree Knight within the Knights of Columbus (KOFC). Edward was an active parishioner at Our Lady of The Springs Catholic Church in Ocala, Florida; he was both a sacristan and Eucharistic Minister. Inside the Sreenan household, Edward was a remarkable husband and a wonderful father. He spent much of his family life in Rockford, Illinois where memories of hunting and snow are vibrant in thought. After retirement, he settled in Ocala, Florida where much time was spent creating everlasting memories with his

surviving wife, Dorothy Sreenan, whom he spent 62 beautiful years with. Edward is also survived by his son, Duane Sreenan, who is utterly appreciative of the love and understanding from which Ed gave. He is survived by his four grandchildren, Amber, Stephanie, Daphne and Lauren Sreenan, four great grandchildren as well as his youngest brother, Joe Sreenan. We invite family and friends to celebrate Edward's life this Saturday February 15, 2014 beginning at 9 A.M.
