Elizabeth A. H. McCormick (nee Hanratty-Jones), of Gainesville, Florida passed away on February 19, 2023.

She was born May 22, 1935 in Glasgow, Scotland. She grew up in Morar, Inverness-shire, Scotland, and graduated from Dingwall Academy, Ross-shire, Scotland. With her husband, she lived in Germany, West Virginia, Texas, Oklahoma, and England. She loved the traveling life in her fifth wheel trailer, spending winters in the South and summers in Canada. Although she left Scotland in 1956, she always retained a soft West Highland accent. In her later years, she became fond of the color violet. She dressed with simple good taste and used very little make-up. Whenever she met someone, that person went away happier because she emanated joy. (Even when she didn't feel that way.) Elizabeth managed to hold the members of her wide-spread family close together by frequent communication with all of them. She was a compulsive reader, frequenting both the Parkersburg WV, Vienna, WV and Marion County FL Public Libraries. She loved Dandie Dinmont Terriers.

She is survived by her husband of 66 years, Lawrence. She was preceded in death by her son, Kevin of Ridgefield Park, New Jersey. Other survivors include her two sons, Sean of Ocoee, FL; and Michael of Clinton, NY, and eight grandchildren.
