Elmo "Sal" Salmon, 90 of Ocala, Florida , passed away Thursday, May 30, 2019 in the home he shared with his loving wife Cora. Sal was born in Marimar, Cuba on June 3rd, 1928. He was the eldest of two sons born to Eldred and Asineth Salmon. E came to America at the age of 12.
