She has been an active member of the First United Methodist Church in Ocala, and previously was Youth Director at Pasadena Community Church in St. Petersburg. Frances and her husband, Bill Carson, met at Hospice of Marion County where they volunteered many hours of service for

18 years and worked with many people in Grief Management. They initiated the Support In Grief program. Their passion was growing roses and sharing her delicious rum cakes with others.
