Obituary of Frank Scinto SCINTO, Frank Angelo, 89, died Feb. 8, 2015, in Tampa, FL. Frank was born to Donato B. "Daniel" Scinto and Lucia Paoletta Scinto on Aug. 21, 1925 in Bridgeport, CT. He moved to Ansonia, CT in 1960 where he lived until moving full-time to Ocala, FL in 1994. He graduated from Harding High School's Class of 1944. As a member of the Greatest Generation and a decorated (Purple Heart) World War II veteran, Frank served his country in the U.S. Army (PFC) as a survey and instrument man with Company K, 47th Infantry Regiment at Normandy. After his military service, he attended the Whitney School of Art in New Haven, where he received an Associate of Arts Degree. Thereafter, he worked for Textron for 27 years until his retirement. Frank was a talented artist and painter; he also loved to play the harmonica. A devoted family man, Frank first married Angelina Mainiero on Aug. 31, 1952, and with her had five children: Gary, Daniel (Penny); James (Wanda); Elaine and Janice (Dean DiRose). Angelina's death parted them on Oct. 26, 1982. Frank next married Cecelia Altieri on May 30, 1983; she predeceased him on Feb. 4, 2009. Frank was also predeceased by his two children Gary and Elaine, his sisters Giani and Eva, and his brother Joseph. Left to cherish his memory are his children: Daniel, James, and Janice; and grandchildren: Marisa Scinto, James Scinto, Elaine (Laney) DiRose and Deanna DiRose. A lifelong Catholic, Frank was a member of Queen of Peach Catholic Church in Ocala. A burial service with full military honors will be held Sunday, March 1, 2015, at 2:00 p.m. at Good
