Frank G. Smith Jr., 64, of Oak Run, Ocala, Florida, passed away on March 9th, 2024, at Ocala Regional Hospital. Frank, affectionately known as "Buddy" by his family. He was born on August 30th, 1959, in Buffalo, New York, to Frank and Dorothy Smith. He spent his formative years in Depew, NY, graduating from Maryvale High School and achieving the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout with the Boy Scouts of America.
