Obituary of Franklin Mackenzie Franklin A. Buck MacKenzie Sr., 85, of Ocala, was born on September 1, 1922 in Bay City, Michigan. He passed away peacefully on April 26, 2008 at Hospices Legacy House, in the company of his dear close friend, Diane Pollak. Buck came to this area 22 years ago from Homestead, FL with his wife, Eunice E. MacKenzie, who preceded him in death in 2005. He was an engineer, master welder, plumber and a blacksmith as well as a superintendant, working for such companies as Dow Chemical and Bechtel Power Co. He worked on such projects as the Belle River Power Plant, the Turkey Point nuclear power plant and the Space Shuttle complex at Vandenberg AFB. He was also a co-owner of MacKenzies Yarn and Fabric Shoppe with his wife Eunice. Buck was a T-4 Sergeant in WWII and served in the 726 Amphibian Tractor Btn Beachhead Assault. He was also a member of VFW #4902 of Ocala, American Legion #284 of Belleview, DAV Chapter #149, Fraternal Order of Eagles Sanford Aerie #3677 MI, La Societe Des 40 Hommes Et 8 Chevauk Locale #1480, Free and Accepted Masons Saginaw Valley Lodge #154, Scottish Rite Consistory, Lodge Council Chapter Valley of Bay City, MI and the Elf Khurafeh Temple Shrine of Saginaw, MI. He is survived by his sons, Michael O. MacKenzie Sr. of Cedar Rapids, IA and Franklin A. MacKenzie Jr. of Frankfort, KY; 8 grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren and 2 great great grandchildren.
