January 20, 1921 - July 14, 2016

Fred J. Krim, 95, passed away on July 14, 2016. He was born in Boston, Massachusetts on January 20, 1921. During World War II, he served three and a half years in the Naval Air Corps seeing duty in the European Theatre. After leaving the service he attended the University of Florida where he completed his undergraduate work and received his LLB Degree in 1951. Upon graduation from law school he joined the staff of United States Fidelity & Guaranty Co., managing that firm's district office in Gainesville for six years. He resigned that position to move to Ocala and join the Savage & Mills law firm. The firm is currently known as Savage, Krim and Simons. He is preceded in death by his beloved wife, Gwendolyn Krim. He is survived by a brother, Harry Krim (Alice). He leaves a daughter, Nancy Pasteur and husband, Chris; son, Joe Krim and wife Holly. He is also survived by loving grandchildren Matthew Pasteur (Kristin), Adam Pasteur, Gwen Pasteur, Jacob Krim (Annie), Kaley Taccetta (Vincent) and three great grandchildren Michael, Gracie, and Eli. The funeral service will be held at 11:30 a.m. on July 21, 2016 at Blessed Trinity Catholic Church. There will be a reception immediately following at the Knights of Columbus Hall located next to the church.
