January 1, 1916 - September 17, 2017

Frederick C. Smail, beloved husband, father, and grandfather passed away peacefully on the afternoon of Sunday, September 17th, 2017 at Emory L. Bennet State Veteran's Nursing Home in Daytona Beach, FL., at the age of 101. Mr. Smail was born on January 1st, 1916 in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, the youngest of 10 siblings.
