Dr. Gary Ernest Stephens, 54 of Ocala, Florida, passed away on October 4, 2024 at home.

Gary was born in Ocala, Florida to the late George and Geraldine McCall Stephens on July 11, 1970. Gary was a 1988 graduate of Dunnellon High School, earned his Bachelors degree in Pre Med from University of Central Florida and went on to earn his Doctorate of Chiropractic at Life University in Marietta, Ga.
