Obituary of Gary Wright Gary Morgan Wright, MD, age 65, died at his home under hospice care on June 4, 2008, of cancer. Dr. Wright was a graduate of Vanderbilt University and the Medical College of Georgia. He served as a flight surgeon in the US Navy during the Vietnam conflict. Dr. Wright received his post-doctoral training at the University of Kentucky, where he served as Chief Resident of Internal Medicine and was a Hematology/Oncology Fellow. During his career, Dr. Wright was active in many professional organizations and was a Past President of Marion County Medical Society. He served on the Marion County Blood Bank (now Central Florida Blood Bank) for 30 years. Dr. Wright was also active in the formation of Ocala Hospice and served two terms as president of Marion County American Cancer Society. He was equally active in his community, spearheading the construction of the soccer complex for the Big Sun Youth Soccer League. Dr. Wright served as a local medical oncologist with Ocala Oncology for thirty years and, in his own words, leaves behind beloved family, good friends, and the many patients he had the privilege and honor of caring for over the years. His family includes his wife of 42 years, Charlotte; daughter Ashley and Gregory Scharpf; daughter Courtney and Bo Jones; son Holland and Margaret Laurie Wright; 6 grandchildren; mother Mildred Wright; and sister Martha and Keller Carlock.
