May 18, 1937 - December 22, 2024

Bishop George C. Parris, 87, of Ocala, Florida, passed away on Sunday, December 22, 2024, in Ocala, Florida.

Bishop Parris was born in Barbados to the late Pastor James and Eudalie Parris

on May 18, 1937. He attended Clifton Hill Boys School in Barbados, Prospect High

School in Brooklyn, NY. He went on to earn the following degrees: Electrical Engineer,

Brooklyn Technical Institute, a Certificate in Evangelism, and an Associate Degree in

Biblical Studies from Bethel Bible Institute, a Master of Theology, and Doctor of

Theology from the International Theological Seminary. He worked as an Electrical

Engineer for Deep Water in Barbados and for the New York City Transit Authority as a

Road Car Inspector for over 20 years. He enjoyed gardening, cooking, reading, baking,

and singing . He received numerous awards, citations, and honors. He established

Hebron Evangelical Churches, in Brooklyn, NY and Ocala, FL, Hebron Bible Institute

and Hebron Evangelical Church Scholarship Fund.

Bishop Parris is survived by his wife Evangelist Dr. Joan Parris, his daughter Dr.

Andrea Parris, brother Bishop Alonzo Parris, sister Muriel Hurdle and a host of nieces,

nephews, relatives, friend and spiritual sons and daughters. He is preceded in death by

his parents Pastor James and Eudalie Parris, siblings Rita Alleyne, Randolph Parris,

Luther Parris, Winifred Bowen, and Elise Marshall.
