Gregory Lee Fox, age 76 of Silver Springs, Florida passed away and entered into Glory on Wednesday, July 10, 2024 at Ocala Regional Medical Center. He was born on Thursday, May 20, 1948 in Amherstdale, West Virginia to William H. "Bill" and Stella B. (Spears) Fox.
