Obituary of Harry Jones JONES, HARRY R. Silver Springs - Mr. Harry R. Jones, 94, passed away on Sunday, March 20th at Munroe Regional Medical Center. Harry was born in Lawrenceville, IL on December 21, 1916 to parents, Clarence and Lettie Jones. In 1955, he married the love of his life, Wilma Brohm of Ocala, and after many years away, they returned to Silver Springs in 1985. Harry was an accomplished self taught artist and produced many paintings, including over 400 of the 600 lighthouses in the United States. He was a Civil war buff and traveled often to gun shows that had weaponry from that era. Harry built drive-in movie theaters in 13 different states, including the Skylark Drive-In in Ocala. He was a Member of the Elks Club #1208 for 75 years and a member of the Free and Accepted Masons Lodge # 164 in Lawrenceville, IL for 64 years. He was preceded in death by Wilma, his loving wife of 56 years. Survivors include his son, Harry Steven Jones of Silver Springs; daughter, Penny Rouse Iannone of Ocala; 2 grandchildren, Leigh T. Iannone of Largo, FL and Harry Steven Jones II of Belvidere, TN; and one great grandson, Layton Miles Jones.
