Harry F. Mooney, 92, of Ocala, Florida, passed away on April 8, 2016. Harry was born and raised in Wheeling, WV. He graduated from Warwood High School in 1941. The Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor in December 1941 and Harry joined the United States Marines in 1942. He was in the Marine Air Corps and landed on many islands in the Pacific, including Hawaii, Johnson Island, The Marshalls, Guadalcanal, Guam, Saipan, Tunisian Iwo Jima, Okinawa and Japan. After the war, Harry attended Ohio State and Ohio Northern Universities and studied Metallurgy. He worked for Teledyne Ohio Steel in Lima, Ohio for 33 years. He retired as the V.P. of Sales in 1988, and moved to Ocala that same year. He was a member of the Association of Iron and Steel Engineers, Masonic Lodge 585 in Lima, Ohio and Golden Hills Golf and Turf Club. He is survived by his wife of 69 years, Mary Dorothy; a son, William Patrick of Castle Rock, CO. and a daughter, Sharon Mooney-Hughes of Amelia Island, FL.; three grandchildren, Nathan Biery, Wendy Mooney Schorsch, Lara Mooney; four great grandchildren, Sean Biery, Jasmine Emerson, Jordan Biery and Maya Fair.
