Obituary of Heather Spitznogle Mrs. Heather M. Spitznogle, 41 passed away on January 30, 2009 in Ocala, Florida. She was born in Bethesda, Maryland on May 2, 1967. She taught at Dunnellon Middle School for 14 years and was a media specialist for 3 years. She was a graduate of Fairmont State University. She was a member of the College Road Baptist Church in Ocala and was chairman for the Dunnellon Relay for Life in 2006 and 2007. She moved to this area in 1990 from W. Virginia. She is preceded in death by her mother Sue Miller and grandparents Olive and Glen McClain also a grandfather Warren Miller. She is survived by her loving husband Paul Sr. of 9 years.
