Obituary of Herbert Fields Mr. Herbert Martin Fields, 91, of Ocala, Florida passed away peacefully on February 15, 2015. Born in Springfield, Missouri to his parents Ada Mallory and Samuel Preston Fields, Mr. Fields resided in Ocala for many years. Mr. Fields was a veteran of the United States Navy and held the ranks of Pharmacist's Mate First Class and Hospital Corpsman First Class. After being honorably discharged from the Navy, he enlisted in the United States Army, retiring after serving over 20 years of dedicated service to his country. He was awarded the "Presidents Hundred Tab" badge which is awarded by the Civilians Marksmanship Program (CMP) to the 100 top-scoring military and civilian shooters in the President's Pistol and President's Rifle Matches. Mr. Fields completed his career assigned to the USA Marksmanship Training Unit at Fort Benning, Georgia. After his career in the military, Mr. Fields worked for the Brinks Security Company which he retired from after 18 years of service. While at Brinks, he held the position as a Brinks trainer and qualified employees in the use of their firearms. Mr. Fields is preceded in death by his wife Lillian Beatrice and his two daughters, Lillian Joyce Voyles and Donna Kay Fields. He is survived by a daughter Diann Devereaux of Ocala, two sons; H. Kieth (Ann) Fields of Ocala and Donald (Robin) Fields of Winder, Georgia; 18 grandchildren, 29 great grandchildren, and 8 great great grandchildren. Visitation and service will be held on Thursday, February 19, 2015 at the Edgewood Church of Christ in Columbus, GA. Burial will follow at the Park Hill Cemetery in Columbus. Local
