Obituary of Herman FullerHerman J. Puffer Fuller, 87, of Ocala, passed away October 6, 2008. Born November 27, 1920 in Tupper Lake, NY to Timothy and Lillian Fuller, at a young age, Mr. Fuller voluntarily joined the US Army in January of 1941 and during WWII served in N. Africa in the First Division before being wounded in 1943. He was honorably discharged in 1945 and went on to work for the Veterans Administration for the remainder of his career. He was a member of Our Lady of the Springs Catholic Church, Ocala, the Knights of Columbus Council #5960. He was also a lifetime member of DAV Chapter 121, a charter member of the Military Order of the Purple Heart Unit #466, the Society of the First Infantry Division, the 16th Infantry Regiment Association and the Silver Springs Shores Elks Lodge #2730. Mr. Fuller was also an avid golfer, sportsman and enjoyed skiing before he moved to Florida in 1975 from North Branch, New Jersey. He is survived by his daughter, Judy C. McGowin of Ocala; granddaughter, Tami J. Wyckoff of Ocala and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wife of 53 years, Marcella L. Fuller and 13 siblings. He was the 12th of 14 children.
