Obituary of Hutton Griffith Hutton Jones Griffith passed away peacefully on Saturday, November 6, 2010 at Hospice's Estelle House. He was born in Guyana, South America on June 24, 1921. Hutton was the husband of Thelma Griffith, Head Start Director at Childhood Development Services, Ocala. The couple moved here from Barbados in 1991. Hutton was the retired Deputy Director of Civil Aviation in Guyana and Secretary of the Air Transport Licensing Authority in Barbados. An ex-serviceman, Hutton served in the British Royal Air Force as a fighter/bomber pilot and a High Altitude Meteorological Pilot. He also held a commercial pilot's license from Oxford Air Training School in England. After his graduation from London School of Economics (LSE) as an Economist, majoring in International Trade and Transport, he served as an Economist with the Guyana Government before returning to England for training in Aviation administration. Hutton was subsequently trained with the British Intelligence Service in police and military security. A keen spokesman, Hutton played cricket, soccer and badminton both in Guyana and for his university in London. His love for physical fitness and body-building earned him the title of Heavy Weight Champion of Guyana, a record that remained unbroken for over a decade. The viewing and funeral service for the late Hutton Griffith will be held at 10AM and 11AM respectively at Christ the King Anglican Church on Saturday, November 13, 2010. Officiating will be The Rev. Donald J. Curran, Jr. The Church is located at the Living Waters Worship Center 3801 N. US Hwy 441. In lieu of floral tributes,
