



## Jack Overcash

June 16, 1946 - July 3, 2016

Jack Overcash, Jr., 70 of Ocklawaha, FL, passed away July 3, 2016 at The Villages Regional Hospital. Jack was born in Gardner, KS on June 16, 1946 and graduated from Gardner High School in 1964. He joined the US Navy at age 19 in 1965, serving on the USS Enterprise (CVN-65), as an Ordnance Mechanic during the Vietnam War. He was honorably discharged in 1971 to attend the Teachers College in Emporia State University. Jack moved to Lakeland, Florida and was a draftsman in the construction industry. He retired in 2010 and then moved to Ocklawaha, Florida in 2011. Jack was a parishioner of Immaculate Heart of Mary Catholic Church of Ocala; he was an artist, he enjoyed wood crafting, sketching and painting. Jack also liked to fish, watch classic films and loved his family above all else. He volunteered many hours working with his children's band boosters (flipping burgers at every home game).
