Obituary of James Booth James H. Booth, 88, retired officer of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, where he also served as a United States Treasury Agent, passed away Monday October 24, 2011. Mr. Booth was born in 1923 in Montclair NJ and was a WWII Army Veteran. He was President of his graduating class at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, and received a Masters Degree at New York University. He taught banking at several Universities for the American Institute of Banking. While living and working in New York he was at one time the President of the Huntington Historical Society. Mr. Booth moved to Florida in 1976. He was a member of the Silver Spring Shores Elks Club and a member of Our Lady of the Springs Parish. He was preceded in death by his first wife Dorothy Thompson Booth who passed away in May of 1994, and his second wife Mary Kezel Booth who passed away in February of 2011. Survivors include his son James K. Booth of Longwood FL, his son Gary C. Booth of Hobe Sound FL, and his grandson Brandon Booth of Longwood FL. Mr. Booth will be laid to rest Dec 2nd at 11:00 am at the National Cemetery in Bushnell, FL.
