James Wyndham Haselden, Sr., 84, of Ocala, died peacefully at home surrounded by family on October 22, 2017. James "Jimmy" is preceded in death by his parents, Rolin Verne Haselden and Grace Wyndham Haselden, and a brother, Rex Haselden.
