



James Phillip Logue

July 1, 1932 - July 5, 2022

On Tuesday, July 5, 2022, James Phillip Logue, loving husband of Sarah L. Logue, was called to Heaven.

James was born to James Henry Logue and Rose Alisa Logue on July 1, 1932 in Brooklyn, New York. He graduated from Brooklyn Technical High School after which he joined the Navy serving for four years as an Aviation Electronics Technician aboard the USS Lake Champlain during the Korean War. Following an Honorable Discharge, Mr. Logue went to Indiana Institute of Technology graduating in 1958 with a B.S. in Electrical Engineering.

Following college, Mr. Logue worked for Dana Corporation, General Electric, RCA Corporation, and Thompson Consumer Electronics. During his time at RCA, Mr. Logue won numerous awards for suggestions for cost reduction and quality leadership, culminating in his being awarded Man of the Year for cost reduction for RCA in 1971/72. Mr. Logue retired from General Electric in 1994.

In 1971, Mr. Logue became interested in breeding Arabian horses. After his retirement in 1994, he devoted his time to this endeavor. He successfully bred and raised Arabians, producing many regional and national winners until 2004. In 2004, Mr. Logue and his wife Sarah moved to Ocala, Florida. Mr. Logue's other hobbies consisted of playing the piano; collecting various RCA paraphernalia; landscaping and enjoying time with his wife, family, friends and his beloved Dobermans: Gunner, Baron and Stryker.

Mr. Logue is survived by his wife, Sarah, five children, Julie, James, Therese (husband Clay), Lisa, Marilyn, fourteen grandchildren, seven great-

grandchildren, loving nephew Aaron Wallenburg (wife Laura); sister-in-laws Alison Comas (husband George) and Melissa Dasch and nieces Chris and Sharon Comas as well as many great nephews and nieces. Burial will be August 19, 2022 at 10:30 am at Florida National Cemetery in Bushnell. A Celebration of Life will be held August 20, 2022, at the Indigo East Community Center, 8385 SW 79th Terrace Rd., Ocala, Florida 34476 from 4 to 6 PM.
