Jerry Hammett, a shining light in every life he touched, left an indelible mark on all who knew him. Born on December 30, 1950, in Swainsboro, Georgia, Jerry's journey led him to Marion County, Florida, where he built a life filled with love, laughter, and purpose. He passed away peacefully on April 27, 2025, surrounded by his devoted family.

A master electrician and dedicated philanthropist, Jerry was known for his quick wit, generous heart, and unwavering commitment to his community. After graduating from Ocala High School in 1968, he served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968 to 1970. He went on to earn an associate's degree from Santa Fe Community College before co-founding Mid State Electric in 1977 with his business partner, Jerry Godwin. Eventually becoming sole owner and President, Jerry brought in his two sons to help grow the company into the thriving business it is today.

Jerry's work brightened not only the buildings he wired but also the lives of everyone he encountered. When not dedicating his time to his business or community, he could often be found on the golf course, fishing, hunting, or cheering on his beloved Florida Gators with unmatched enthusiasm.

His service extended far beyond the workplace. Jerry was an active member of numerous organizations including the Bonita Club, the Board of Code

Enforcement, the Elks Club, and the Florida Association of Electrical Contractors (FAEC), where his leadership and generosity made a lasting impact.

Jerry's greatest pride and joy was his family. He is survived by his loving wife of 53 years, Deborah Hammett; his sons, Brian "BJ" Hammett (Jamie) and Brad Hammett (Chrissy); and his cherished grandchildren, Taylor, Braylon, Peyton, Blake, and Bentley. He also leaves behind his brother, Randy Hammett (Cindy), and a host of extended family, dedicated employees, and friends who will miss him dearly.
