Obituary for Jewel Faye Roberts Jewel Faye McCully Roberts was born on January 22, 1926 in Fellowship, Florida and departed this life on March 10, 2017 in Louisville, Kentucky. She was the daughter of Harry Jackson McCully and Jewel Winona Marlowe McCully, both of whom preceded her in death. From this union came five boys and two daughters. Jewel Faye was the fourth to be born. She was united in marriage to Maynard Roberts at Fellowship Baptist Church in 1947. They were married for 61 years until Maynard's death in 2008. Jewel Faye was a graduate of John B. Stetson University and served twenty-eight years as a public school teacher for Hillsborough County. She served as church organist and/or pianist for much of her life, beginning as a child at Fellowship Baptist Church, and later at First Baptist Church, Dover and College Road Baptist Church, Ocala. Upon her retirement as church musician, College Road Baptist Church bestowed on her the title of Organist Emeritus. Jewel Faye is survived by her son, Wesley, and his wife, Sida, of Campbellsville, Kentucky; two granddaughters Emmanuelle Sida and her husband, Shannon McClung, of Burbank, California, and Gabrielle Jewel and her husband, Thomas Sweets, of Chattanooga, Tennessee; three great-grandchildren: Isaac Wesley, Nathanael Martin, and Lydia Joan; one sister, Shirley Tillis of Ocala; two sisters-in-law Florence McCully of Plantation, Florida and Doris McCully of Orlando, Florida; 9 nephews, 11 nieces; 23 grandnephews, 18 grandnieces; 9 great-grand nephews, and 6 great-grand nieces. Cotney at 11:00 a.m. on March 17 at College Road Baptist Church, Ocala,  
with interment at Florida National Cemetery, Bushnell.
