Joan Ann DeLuca, 88, of Ocala, Florida, passed away peacefully in her home on December 24, 2024. Joan Ann was born in Elizabeth, New Jersey, to Thomas and Mary Caivano on June 17, 1936. She attended Batten High School in Elizabeth and graduated in 1954. She went on to earn her RN degree from Elizabeth General Hospital School of Nursing in 1957. She worked as the head nurse on the OBGYN floor of Rahway Hospital in Rahway, N.J., for many years. Later in life, Joan Ann and her husband Joseph opened a family business selling fine arts and collectibles called DeLuca's Galleries in Scotch Plains, N.J. Her and her husband were chartered members of the Gran Centurions Italian American Club in Clark, N.J., where they were involved in several charitable groups for which Joan Ann received many honorable awards. She and her husband lived in Clark, N.J., for many years before retiring to Royal Palm Beach, Florida, in 1997, where she continued to do volunteer work in her church and with the local Hospice organization in Palm Beach County. She and her husband, Joseph, of 65 years, relocated within the past year to Ocala, Florida, to reside with their daughter and son-in-law.
