Obituary of Joel Taylor Joel Kenton Taylor, 52 of Ocala, Florida passed away October 22, 2014. Born in Fort Valley, Georgia, he was a 20 year veteran of the United States Air Force retiring after 20 years of dedicated service to his country. He was known by many names, Ken, Msgt Taylor, Doc, Joele, Knight, Uncle, Cousin, Dad, Son and Gefash. In his life he was a dishwasher, a salad prep worker, a floor sweeper, a truss maker, a student, an Air Force Medic, a computer technician, a cable technician and a teacher. his lifetime, he loved teaching most of all, and especially teaching the word of the Lord. Ken is laid to rest not out of cowardness, but in fighting for righteousness in an unrighteous world. Proclaiming his innocence to his last breath on earth and then absolved in Heaven. Ken wrote, "I love my wife, kids, grandson and parents with all my heart. I would never do anything to harm my family. I pray that the lesson God has from this will endure in the hearts of my family. Word can hurt people". Ken's desire was to be cremated with a simple ceremony.
